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Cut out the pictures and randomly place them in rows, facedown, on the table. Take turns turning over two pictures and saying the beginning sounds in their names. If the sounds are the same, set the pair aside, but do not rearrange the other pictures. If the pictured items do not have the same beginning sound, turn them over again, leaving them in their original places.

The object of the game is to collect the most pairs. When the game is over, ask your child to check all the pairs to make sure they have the same beginning sounds by saying each word aloud and giving its beginning sound.

Answers: cow/cat, ring/rain, pie/pencil, bird/bat/bell/bike, watermelon/wing, tire/table/turtle/toaster, scissors/sock, fox/fork
