**Open Lunch Contract- 2019-2020**

**Rules and Regulations:**

1. Students must obtain parent/guardian permission on the attached parental consent form before they are eligible for the program.
  2. Students must report to the main entrance and sign-out with the school personnel on duty before leaving school grounds. **Each student must sign him/herself out.** If a student leaves lunch without signing out, it will be considered a regular lunch-cut and disciplinary action will be imposed. If this occurs two times, then open lunch privileges will be permanently revoked.
  3. Students are to exit and re-enter through **the main entrance only** and are not permitted to loiter on school grounds. Students whom exit or re-enter via a door outside of the main entrance and/or any student(s) who opens a non-main entrance door for another student(s), will be subject to disciplinary action. Upon re-entry, students must sign-in prior to their next scheduled class through the main entrance. If a student fails to sign in more than two times, open lunch privilege will be permanently revoked.
  4. Students may not leave the building and re-enter with purchased food.
  5. If a student is late to the class following lunch, the teacher will mark him/her late. If a student fails to return to school at all, it will be considered a class-cut and disciplinary consequences will be imposed.
  6. Open lunch privilege may be revoked on an individual or group basis by the administration for any disciplinary reason.
  7. Students who wish to use the school media center during their lunch period should remain in school and make use of the procedures for using the media center.
  8. Students reported as being a public nuisance, speeding, driving recklessly, or engaging in illegal activity while on or off campus, may have their open lunch privilege revoked.
  9. Students in violation of the NPHS parking regulations may have their open lunch privilege revoked and/or result in disciplinary action.
  10. Students in violation of the NPHS Code of Conduct may have their open lunch privilege revoked at the discretion of the High School administration.

**By signing on the previous page, I understand that open lunch is a privilege given by New Providence High School and that my conduct must be representative of this privilege. I agree to conduct myself in the same manner that is expected in school. I understand that my privilege may be revoked if I fail to comply with any of the above regulations and I am subject to further disciplinary action based on any infractions of the open lunch rules and regulations.**
