RANDOM SELECTION ON-CAMPUS SENIOR PRIORITY PARKING

Any senior who turns seventeen by October 31, 2019 is eligible for the Random Selection On-Campus Priority Parking. Students must read and complete the Parking Privileges/Application sheet prior to the random selection which will be granted on a 2-semester calendar basis. Students who are chosen through the first random selection will be assigned a parking spot in the on-campus senior parking lot for the first semester, which will run from September- January. Any senior who completed an application but is not awarded a spot in the first random selection, will be entered into the second automatically, for the second semester, which will run from February through June. Any student who does not submit an application in September, but will have a driver's license and/or car by January 31st may submit an application during that time. Parking space numbers will be chosen randomly and without names being known during the selection.

Any car found parked in the student lot without a permit or in either faculty parking lot will have their parking privileges revoked, and may receive a Saturday detention. Students may not move their cars into vacant faculty spots to be near the weight room, gyms, or athletic fields at any time. Please do not park in areas where you are not authorized to park. All cars parked on New Providence High School property must display a hang tag. If you lose this tag, a \$5.00 replacement fee will be assessed.

We are happy to announce that the Borough of New Providence has approved our request to utilize the Community Pool Parking lot for senior students. Seniors who do not receive an on-campus spot through the random selection, will be allowed to park in the first two rows of the first section of the Community Pool parking lot. We expect this solution to alleviate the issue of students having difficulty finding parking on the street that is not limited to 2 hours.

The same rules and regulations that seniors must adhere to in our on-campus parking lot will apply when using the Community Pool parking lot. All students who have activities during after-school hours must move their vehicles from the Community Pool parking lot to on-campus parking at the end of the school day.

In the event that inclement weather causes school delays and/or closures, the Community Pool parking lot will be closed until proper snow removal has occurred. Please plan to carpool on these days.

RANDOM SELECTION GUIDELINES

- **September 4th-11th, 2019**—Applications will be accepted in the Main Office.
- **September 11th, 2019**—Applications due in the Principal's Office by 3:00 p.m.
- **September 16th, 2019**—First semester on-campus priority parking winners will be notified by school email. Students may pick up their parking permit and spot number in the Main Office at lunch or after school.
- **January 17th, 2020**—Any senior who completed an application but was not awarded a spot in the first random selection, will be entered into the second automatically, for the second semester, which will run from February through June. Any student who did not submit an application in September, but will have a driver's license and/or car by January 31st may submit an application to the Principal's Office at this time (January 17, 2020).
- **January 31st, 2020**—Second semester on-campus priority parking winners will be notified by school email. Students may pick up their parking permit and spot number in the Main Office at lunch or after school.

RANDOM SELECTION ON-CAMPUS SENIOR PRIORITY PARKING

Be sure to read and complete both sides of the application. PARKING PRIVILEGES and APPLICATION

In order to avoid any problems concerning parking privileges at New Providence High School, the following regulations must be adhered to by all students.

1. Students must have a valid New Jersey driver's license and vehicle registration.
2. Only the car registered by the student can be parked in the school lot. The parking tag must be displayed on the rearview mirror and cannot be transferred to another person.
3. No one is allowed to park in your space even with your permission and you are not allowed to use any other space for any reason.
4. Students are not permitted to go to their cars without permission from an administrator.
5. Smoking, including electronic devices, are not permitted on school grounds at any time (this means that students may not smoke in their cars on school grounds).
6. Careless driving or speeding (more than 10 miles per hour) is not permitted.
7. Repeated tardiness and absenteeism will result in the loss of parking privileges.
8. Violations of the Code of Conduct will result in the loss of parking privileges and eligibility for the on-campus priority parking.
9. Any student who leaves the parking lot without permission will have his/her parking privilege revoked.
10. Students may not move their cars into vacant faculty spots to be near the weight room, gyms, or athletic fields.

Any infraction of the above rules will result in the loss of Parking Privileges and may additionally lead to disciplinary measures.
