




Student Spotlight!

2022-2023 Preschool Lottery Information


The preschool lottery classes for the 2022-2023 school year will be drawn from applications the week of January 10, 2022.

Student applicants must be residents of New Providence and have birth dates between October 2, 2017 and October 1, 2018. Special education students are included in the Preschool Program as determined by the District Child Study Team. All general education children must be toilet trained.

An original birth certificate and proof of residency will be required for those students admitted to the program. Admission to the class is only valid for one school year, and a tuition fee of \$330 per month will be charged. Families must provide transportation. There are three classes, all of which meet at Allen W. Roberts School. The morning class meets 8:40 AM-11:10 AM, and the afternoon classes meet 11:50 AM-2:20 PM.
